Bamboo charcoal contains antioxidants that help neutralize free radicals and protect the skin from oxidative damage. Its particles have a slightly granular texture, ideal for gentle exfoliation. While removing dead skin cells, it unclogs pores and promotes cell renewal, for smoother, brighter skin. Utilizations

Bath Bombs:

Add 3g of activated bamboo charcoal per 454g of your bath bomb mix.

Soaps:

Activated Charcoal mix for melt and pour soap per 454g of soap base:

3g of activated bamboo charcoal.

15ml of 99% isopropyl alcohol.

Activated bamboo charcoal mix for cold and hot process soap per 454g of soap base:

5-10g of activated bamboo charcoal added directly to the mixture and mixed with a hand blender.

As a mask:

Place the activated charcoal in a non-metallic dish, pour in warm water, stir until creamy. Apply to your skin and leave on for 5 to 20 minutes. Rinse and pat dry.

Caution: Using too much activated charcoal can lead to residue in the sink or shower.

Recommendations

The dosage suggested above is for information only; more or less can be used according to your recipes. We suggest you always carry out final tests with your products.

More or less activated bamboo charcoal can be added to your bases to achieve the desired color.

This charcoal is a dark black powder and will give a beautiful gray to black hue to your soaps depending on the amount of activated bamboo charcoal added to your soap base.
